# Testicular Torsion

- **Inclusion**: any male <18y presenting with testicular pain
- Triage nurse to put **TT** on tracking board and notify fellow IMMEDIATELY
- POCUS performed by fellow prior to formal US
- **Goal**: 70 patients (enrolled 4)

# Long Bone Fracture

- **Inclusion**: any child <18y with arm (wrist/elbow) or leg (knee/ankle) pain
- Triage nurse to put **LBFX** on tracking board and notify attending/fellow IMMEDIATELY
- If pt in waiting room, triage nurse should ask an attending to order pain meds immediately
- **GOAL**: pain Rx <30min of ARRIVAL

# Strep PCR

- **Inclusion**: Any child requiring strep swab per physician discretion
- Inform fellow/attending who will page Jamal @ 92457
- Strep PCR will be collected (by RA) in addition to regular strep swab.
- **Goal**: 400 PCR swabs by June 2018

# Happee Pee Study

- **Inclusion**: any child <6m who needs UA/UC
- Recruitment extended to June 30, 2018
- Inform fellow/attending for enrollment
- **Goal**: 200 patients (currently at 110)

# Asthma Referral

- **Inclusion**: Children 12-16 with asthma exacerbation
- Refer to black metal file holder in each pod for study materials to refer patient to a home-based asthma management program
- Completed contact information is to be placed back in the metal file holder
- ED staff checks box and signs verifying the Asthma Action Plan as part of study packet was given to family
